1. Call to Order

Hughey presented that the mosaic was installed in both locations. One has not completed the trim work yet. The one at 301 has been plated in the windows. It was asked that they be mounted outside but they ran out of money for the project. Dwyer asked how long they will be displayed and stated that the building owners may have concerns.

Hughey asked if everyone could look this over and see what topics they would like him to attend. Casper asked if the members could attend. Hughey will look into that to see if there are funds.

E. Update on Public Engagement

Hughey will then present them to the City Administrative for final approval to launch the targeted audience. Suggested a meeting with Main Street.

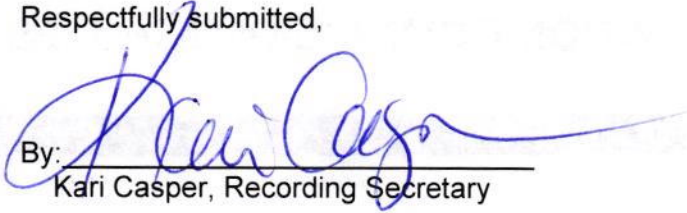
