Call to Order

The meeting of the Charitable Gambling Advisory Board was called to order by Chairperson Rick Caron at 6:00 pm. Board members Chad Koepke, Faribault Youth Rotary Services, Councilor Sara Caron, Terry Meschke, Morristown Fire Relief Association, Peter Dodge, Knights of Columbus, Jason Tobin, Faribault Wrestling, Mike Donkers, Elks, Phillip Parrish, Divine Mercy, Troy Marquardt, Bethlehem Academy, Ed Little, American Legion, Horace Vigessa, Moose, and Heather Slechta, City Clerk were also in attendance.

Approval of the Minutes

Motion by Meschke, seconded by Marquardt to approve the minutes of the August 30, 2023 Charitable Gambling Bard Meeting.

Review Gambling Requests

No Tummies Left Behind/Faribault Foundation

No Tummies Left Behind/Faribault Foundation requested \$1,400.00 to assist in funding for the Basic Blessing Backpacks through the Community Action Council, that helps feed children outside of school times and weekends.

Motion by Vigessa, seconded by Caron to recommend to the City Council a donation of \$1,400.00 be made from the Charitable Gambling Fund to No Tummies Left Behind/Faribault Foundation and carried unanimously.

Rice County Historical Society

The Rice County Historical Society requested \$23,570.00 to pay for reconstruction of the front porch of the Faribault House. David Nichols explained that repairs would make the Faribault House more accessible and that without funding, he was not sure how they would pay for the repairs.

Koepke asked if there were any state or federal grants that would pay for this project, Nichols stated that it is not significant enough for federal grants. Caron asked if the Faribault House generates any revenue, Nichols stated that it does charge entrance fees, and does have a renter, however, they only pay for utilities. Councilor Caron stated that history is very important and requested that the board at least fund half of the project. Tobin was comfortable with donating \$5,000.00-\$8,000.00. Vigessa stated that it was a large request, however, it is important.

Motion by Dodge, seconded by Koepke to recommend to the City Council a donation of \$8,000.00 donation be made from the Charitable Gambling Fund to the Rice County Historical Society. The motion was carried 6:5 with R.Caron, Little, Donkers, Vigessa and Phillip voting Nay.

Chamber Trust

Nort Johnson on behalf of the Chamber Trust requested \$20,000.00 for the Cradle to Career program. Johnson explained that the program supports the development and maintenance of a data-based community wide approach to improving outcomes for every Faribault student. The partnership includes the Faribault Public Schools, Healthy Community Initiative, and the Chamber Trust.

Caron asked what would happen if they do not receive funding, Johnson stated that they would have

to cut back on services, but they would keep the data gathering. Koepke asked what the action team, as that is the highest expense. Johnson stated that it sends teachers to training in Duluth and San Diego. Councilor Caron was in support of funding this project since it helps the schools. Phillips stated that there is typically a partnership with local businesses and they are the driving forces for this type of program and fund it.

Motion by R. Caron, seconded by Tobin to recommend to the City Council a donation of \$5,000.00 be made from the Charitable Gambling Fund to the Chamber Trust to use towards costs associated with the Cradle to Career program and carried unanimously.

Hope Center

Erica Staab-Absher on behalf of the Hope Center requested \$7,200.00 to use towards utility costs associated with the operations of the Hope Center, including phone and internet. Staab-Absher stated that funding at the state and federal level has been cut over the last few years.

Motion by Phillip, seconded by Councilor Caron to recommend to the City Council a donation of \$7,200.00 be made from the Charitable Gambling Fund and carried unanimously.

Sunshine Fund-Semcac

Deb Kauffmann requested \$1,000.00 for music and decorations for senior dining at Buckham West Senior Center.

Motion by Marquardt, seconded by Tobin to recommend to the City Council a donation of \$1,000.00 be made from the Charitable Gambling Fund to Buckham West and carried unanimously.

2024 Fireworks Discussion

The consensus of the Charitable Gambling Board was to again donate \$15,000.00 to the Fourth of July Fireworks. City Clerk Heather Slechta will put together a RFP and send it out to firework vendors in December or early January.

Gambling Fund Report to Date

The gambling fund report was reviewed.

Set 2024 Meeting Dates

The consensus of the Charitable Gambling Board was to continue to meet quarterly in February, May, August and November on the third Wednesday of the month at 6:00 pm.

Adjournment

Motion by Meschke, seconded by Tobin to adjourn the meeting and carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:11 pm.

Display Plan

Overview

Our approach to your fireworks display this year is all about creativity and design. We never want our shows to become boring or repetitive. What you'll see is an ever-changing series of tastefully paired effects which moves from theme to theme like a piece of music.

Our goal is to do this on a large scale while maintaining an exciting pace. Our selection of 965 effects includes our own made-to-spec J&M brand shells as well as hand-picked premium special effects that will be seen city-wide and maintain a fun and fast-paced spectacle from start to finish.

Key Highlights

1. **Big Scale, Big Value:** We focused on large shells to be seen from afar. Our J&M brand assortments are both high quality and cost effective so we can make your show exciting no matter where you watch.
2. **Bigger, Louder, Longer Finale:** 11 finale strings, over 210 shots from our box items, and dozens of large, premium shells are lined up for the big ending. And we mean big.
3. **Creative Touch:** Distinctive, themed chapters where the effects compliment each other perfectly. Each effect is meticulously scripted with a 3D design program for precise timing and to ensure quality. We create every show from scratch to make sure yours is unique and fresh.

Opening 30 sec

May I have your attention... The show has begun and everyone's about to know it! For the first 30 seconds we'll tease what's to come in the finale with an intense build up of bright colors, crackles and whistles. Just as this reaches the peak, we'll move right on to showcasing some massive 5" and 6" premium effects for the first theme of the main body.

Main Body 18 min

The body of the show has approximately 320 full-size shells and 200 shots from our barrage units (cakes) averaging around 30 shots per minute!

For the bulk of the display we will shift from 30 second - 2 minute long themed segments with complimenting colors, effects, sizes and sounds. By grouping effects in this way instead of just randomly mixing, we ensure there is a distinct sense of variety as the show clearly highlights each theme and moves on to the next. The following are just a few examples of how we like to pair effects:

Stars and Stripes - Patriotic colors and effects. Classic 4th of July red, white and blue colors with crackles, whistles, and sparkling gold which are a hallmark of Independence Day displays.

Rainbows and Strobes - All the colors of the rainbow. We have disco ball-like strobing shells and roman candle-like comet cakes all of which combine for a fan favorite theme among the young audience.

Splitters and Swimmers - Crossettes that split apart and "swimming" fireworks that are self-propelled and fly off in random directions. We have a lot of cool variations to show off.

Crackles, Glitter and Weeping Willows - Everyone oohs and ahhs for the willows. No show is complete without them and we source some of the biggest, longest lasting in the industry.

Premium and Unique Special Effects - We have a ton of neat effects that will make you wonder how in the world they do that. From ghost peonies, to tourbillons, to smileys and heart shapes we promise you'll hear the word "woah!" on repeat.

Grand Finale 90 sec

Some finales can be a short blast of shells at the end, not this one. We spend the most time on this piece of the show, and we are confident it will leave a lasting impression.

We build our finales in layers, adding more and more and more for as long as we can. Whistles and loud booms will cue the cheers as the effects just continue to build up until finally a rain of golden glittering willows and rapid salutes close the curtain in style. You can think of it as stages:

Stage 1 - Big shells halt, rapid low effects start. Stage 2 - Introduce mid layers and ramp speed, add noise. Stage 3 - Big shells return, high speed. Mid layers out to left / right angles. Stage 4 - Launch finale strings.

For your big ending, we chose to go with a patriotic spectacle of red, white and blue, with tasteful splashes of vibrant colors and rising silver tails to guide the eyes and enhance the anticipation.

Transportation and List of Explosives

- Prior to the day of the display, all fireworks will be stored at a J&M facility and will be transported, fired, and returned, if necessary, only on the day of the display.
- All fireworks are transported by a DOT HazMat driver with a minimum Class C Commercial Driver's License.
- Drivers are required to carry a Bill of Lading. This Bill of Lading provides the total number of cases and weight of the 1.3G, 1.4G and 1.4S classification.
- In addition to the Bill of Lading, we provide our operators with a packing list which provides the fireworks device name, inventory number, and quantity of each item to be used in the display.

Day of Display – Sequence of Events

- Our crew will arrive at a pre-arranged time, and begin work immediately upon arrival.
- J&M crew members will assist in on-site security and will not leave the display site once work has begun.
- The crew will begin staging the fireworks according to a written diagram, which is provided to and overseen by the lead operator. The crew will load fireworks into mortars and racking designed according to recommendations by the NFPA. All fireworks are wired with electronic igniters and fired from a remote location.
- After all the firework devices are loaded and wired, the modules are connected by cabling to the firing system and a test will be performed. Continuity testing is typically performed between 5:00 PM and 8:00 PM depending on the pace of the crew.
- Prior to running the test, the crew will ensure that there are no persons near the firework staging area. If any bad connections exist, the firing system will be disconnected from the cabling before a crew member will approach and fix the connection. The system will not be connected or powered on until the site is cleared once again. This process will repeat if necessary.
- Once a 100% connection is established, the system will be disconnected and the battery removed until close to the time of display. Another test will be performed approximately 15-30 minutes prior to the display.

Firing of the Display and Post-Display Procedures

- Just prior to firing the display, the lead operator will evaluate wind conditions, ensure that spectators are maintaining an appropriate distance, and that the launch site is 100% clear of all persons and unnecessary equipment. If conditions are deemed unsafe, the lead operator will stop immediately and consult the AHJ (Authority Having Jurisdiction) and the sponsor.
- The Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) is the Fire Chief. If the AHJ does not approve of conditions at any point, they have the final decision to stop/prevent the display at any time.

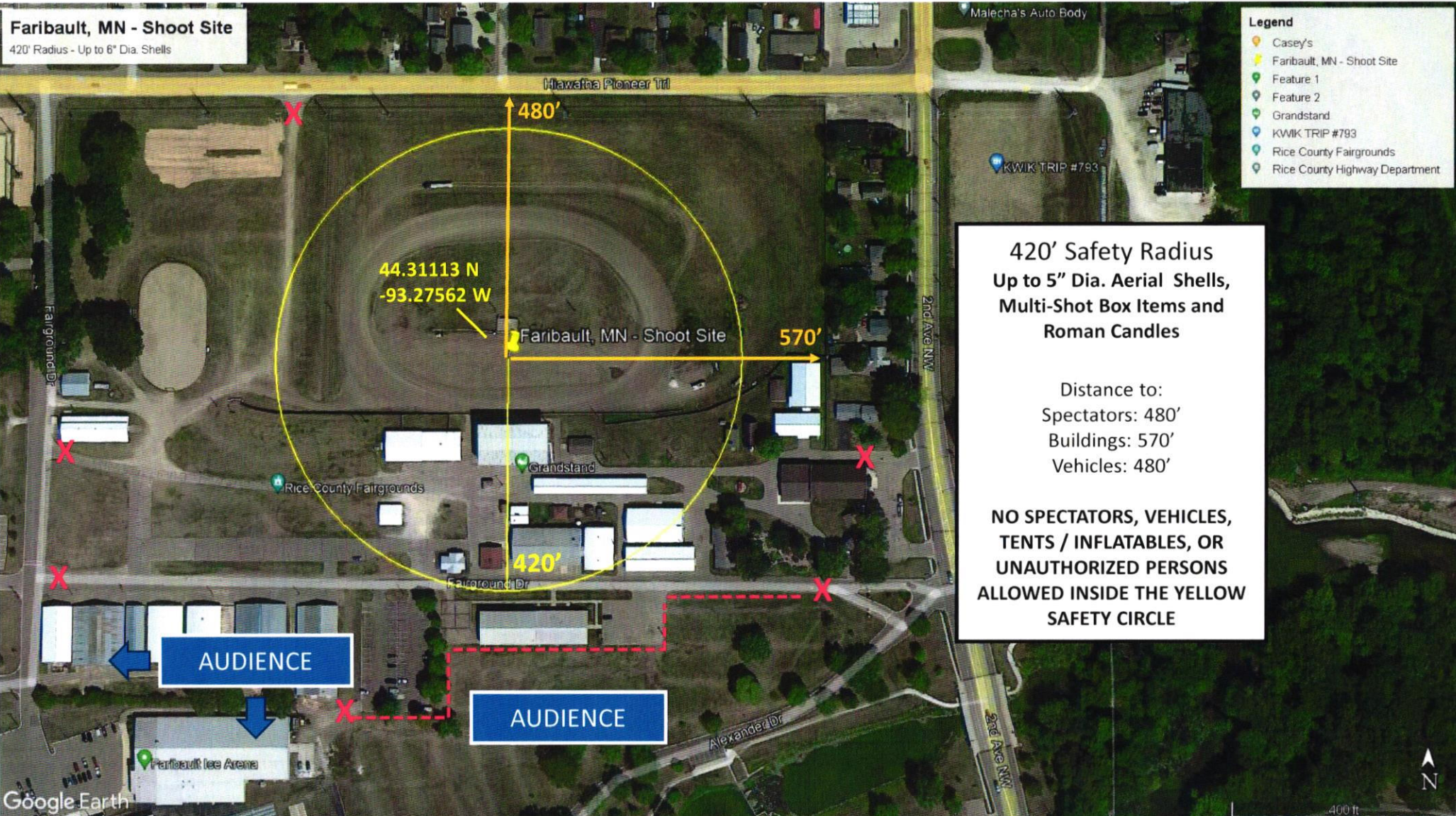
- At display time, the lead operator typically positions themselves at the back of the truck with a "spotter" positioned nearby to observe and report to the shooter. Other crew members will be positioned as additional spotters and safety monitors to assist with site security.
- During the firing of the display, these spotters will constantly monitor for safety and misfires and will stay in communication with the shooter at all times.
- Following the display, our crew will return to the firing system location. After a minimum 10-minute cooldown, the lead operator will inspect the site to ensure all devices have fired and it is safe for the crew to enter. Any small fires and hot embers can be extinguished by the crew. If further assistance is required, the lead operator will request help from the fire department.
- After the inspection is performed and the site is deemed safe, racking and equipment will be dismantled and packed in the truck. The site will then once again be inspected. Additionally, the grounds will be raked/swept and the crew will clean up as much trash and debris as they are able. All trash is loaded into the truck and disposed at our facility.

Severe Weather and Evacuation Plan

- Our goal is to shoot your display at the arranged display time even if our crew encounters some minor inclement weather. Any weather delays that may cause the display to be fired at a later time or a different date will be discussed with the sponsor and J&M Displays office staff.
- Our lead operator will discuss weather with the sponsor and/or the AHJ upon arrival and periodically throughout the day if necessary.
- Our crew is provided with plastic sheeting, shrink wrap, and plastic bags to cover the fireworks devices and equipment in the event of rain.
- If severe weather is anticipated, our crew will work up until the storm approaches as long as the event has not been cancelled or postponed. All fireworks will remain in the truck until they are ready to be loaded.
- We cannot load fireworks if lightning, thunder, or heavy rain is in the area. If an extended delay threatens to push back the display time, our lead operator will discuss a plan with the sponsor.
- In the event of postponement, where inclement weather pushes the display to its backup date, the site will be covered and a security plan will be established so that the site is monitored at all times.
- If the show should be cancelled or postponed to a date beyond the following day, J&M crew members will dismantle all equipment and fireworks and return them to our facility.

Misfire or Dud Procedures

- Post display, the immediate shoot site will be inspected for any potential unfired explosives. In the event an unfired device is found, it will be packed in an approved shipping box and returned to our facility for proper inspection.
- Our crew is provided with instructions for proper packing procedures and all shipping boxes and anti-static bags are held intact in the event of a returned item.

Seller shall furnish to Buyer one (1) fireworks display, as per the \$_____ program (the "Fireworks Program") submitted to and accepted by the Buyer, and which by reference is made a part hereof as Exhibit A. The display is to take place on the evening of _____, 20____ at approximately _____ p.m., weather permitting.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

I. FIRING OF DISPLAY

- a. Seller agrees to furnish all necessary fireworks display materials and personnel for a professional fireworks display in accordance with the Fireworks Program approved by the Parties. Seller agrees to comply with all local, state, and federal regulations and guidelines pertaining to the storing and displaying of fireworks. Seller, with Buyer's assistance, shall obtain any necessary permits for the fireworks display.
- b. Buyer Agrees to provide:
 - i. Sufficient area for the display, including a minimum spectator set back as determined by Seller;
 - ii. Protection of the display area by roping off or similar facility;
 - iii. Adequate police or security protection to prevent spectators from entering the display area; and
 - iv. Persons to assist in the inspection and cleanup of fireworks debris in the fallout zone of the shoot site at first light in the morning following the display;
- c. The cost and acquisition of any site-specific materials or display restrictions (such as sand or the use of a barge) shall be discussed prior to adoption of this Agreement, and the Party responsible for any such acquisition and cost shall be specifically laid out in the Fireworks Program (Exhibit A).
- d. Buyer understands that its failure to provide an appropriate area for the fireworks display, with requirement minimum setbacks and security, may result in a change to Buyer's display (such as a restriction on the type(s) of products which can be utilized) or a cancellation of the display for safety reasons, at Seller's sole discretion. In such event, if Buyer cannot immediately remedy the setback or security concern prior to the Display time noted above, Buyer remains responsible for the entire purchase price of the display regardless of any limitation or cancellation of the display.

II. PAYMENT. The Buyer shall pay to the Seller (check one of the below options):

- ☐ The sum of \$_____ as a down payment upon execution of this Agreement. The balance of \$_____ shall be due and payable within fifteen (15) days after the date of the fireworks display. A service charge of one and one-half percent (1 ½ %) per month shall be added to the unpaid balance if the account is not paid in full with the fifteen (15) days from the date of the display. If this account remains unpaid and is turned over to a collection agency for non-payment, all fees incurred in collecting the balance will be at the Buyer's expense. All returned checks will be assessed a \$30.00 fee.
- ☐ \$_____ in full by _____ (70 days prior to the display date). The Buyer will receive 8% prepayment bonus product in this fireworks display.
- ☐ \$_____ in full by _____ (30 days prior to the display date). The Buyer will receive 5% prepayment bonus product in this fireworks display.

III. LOYALTY PROGRAM

- a. Seller has in place a bonus system for Buyer's who purchase their fireworks displays exclusively from Seller year-to-year. The full terms of Seller's loyalty program have been provided to Buyer with the Program and are available on J&M's website.
- b. Pursuant to Buyer's status in the loyalty program, Buyer will receive an additional ☐ 5% ☐ 10% ☒ 15% (check one) bonus product for this display.

IV. POSTPONEMENT/CANCELLATION

- a. Rain Date: Should inclement weather prevent the firing of the display on the date intended, the Parties agree to a mutually convenient rain date of _____ or another date as agreed to by both Parties. Once display set-up has begun, the determination to cancel the fireworks display because of inclement weather or unsafe weather conditions shall rest within the sole discretion of the Seller, the Authority Having Jurisdiction, and the Seller's lead pyrotechnician.
- b. Except as specifically provided for elsewhere in this Agreement, neither Party will be liable for any failure or delay in performing an obligation under this Agreement that is due to any of the following causes (hereinafter referred to as "Force Majeure"), to the extent beyond the Party's reasonable control: acts of God, accident, riots, public disturbances including but not limited to an active-shooter situation, war, terrorist act, epidemic, pandemic, quarantine, civil commotion, breakdown of communication facilities, natural catastrophes, governmental acts or omissions, changes in laws or regulations, national strikes, fire, explosion, or generalized lack of availability of raw materials or energy.
- c. Disruption of Services due to Covid-19, supply chain disruptions, and public health. Fireworks displays and related events are prone to cancellation due to the ongoing and unforeseeable nature of the Covid-19 pandemic and related health issues, government intervention (such as stay-at-home orders or restrictions on gatherings), and unavailability of supplies and personnel. As such, Seller will work with all customers to ensure a timely and safe display, but due to circumstances outside Seller's and Buyer's control, certain fireworks displays may have to be cancelled or rescheduled with limited notice. Each Party's obligations to perform hereunder will be excused in the case of a Force Majeure Event, which is defined to include (but is not limited to) supply chain disruptions which prevent Seller from obtaining the necessary materials to perform the Display; medical conditions which result in quarantine or similar limitations, or restrictions on travel or congregation in the metropolitan area where the Display is scheduled to be held; and death, serious illness or incapacity of one or more of the display Shoot Team member(s) which renders it impossible, unsafe, or not reasonably practical for the Shoot Team to perform the display.

A governmental or municipal Buyer, who in its discretion and control, acts or adopts a restriction on public gatherings shall not be relieved of its obligations under the Force Majeure provisions of this Agreement. A Buyer who anticipates any such restriction or potential cancellation shall immediately notify and contact Seller to discuss alternative arrangements.

- d. Unless specified above: Displays postponed to an alternate date will be charged and additional 15% of the total contract price for additional expenses incurred in presenting the display on an alternate date; for Displays canceled and not rescheduled within the same calendar year, Seller shall be entitled to 20% of the contract price for out-of-pocket expenses incurred in preparation for the display.

V. INSURANCE and LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY

- a. Seller agrees to provide, at its expense, general liability insurance coverage in an amount not less than \$10,000,000, and within two (2) weeks prior to the date of the fireworks display, shall submit to Buyer, if requested in writing, a certificate of insurance. All entities listed on the certificate of insurance will be deemed an additional insured. In the event of a claim by Buyer, the applicable deductible shall be paid by the Seller.

The Seller agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Buyer and its agents and employees from and against all claims, costs, judgments, damages and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees that

may or shall arise out of any negligent or wrongful act or omission by the Seller related to the performance of the fireworks for the Buyer. The Buyer agrees to give the Seller prompt notice of any claims or demands and to cooperate with the Seller or its successors in interest or assigns, if any, in the defense of any such claims and/or demands.

- b. Separate from, and in addition to Seller's insurance of the fireworks, Buyer agrees to provide, at its expense, a general liability policy or "special event" insurance coverage, in an amount sufficient to meet or exceed municipality or industry standards and all applicable requirements of local, state, and federal law. For any injury or property claims that may arise during the course of Buyer's event, not arising out of Seller's acts or the performance of the fireworks, Buyer's insurance shall be primary. Buyer agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Seller and its agents and employees from and against all such claims, costs, judgments, damages and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees that may or shall arise out of any negligent or wrongful act or omission by the Buyer or third-parties occurring during the course of Buyer's event.
- c. In no event shall Seller's liability to Buyer arising out of or related to this Agreement, whether arising out of or related to breach of contract, tort (including negligence), or otherwise, exceed the aggregate amount of insurance coverage as described in this section. Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary, in no event shall either Party be liable to the other, or to any third party, for any loss of use, revenue or profit, or for any consequential, incidental, indirect, exemplary, special, or punitive damages whether arising out of breach of contract, tort (including negligence), or otherwise, regardless of whether such damage was foreseeable and whether or not such party has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

VI. Each Party has read all of the provisions of this Agreement, they understand all of its provisions, and agree to be bound by them. This written contract, and its Exhibits, contains the entire agreement of the Parties and modifies and supersedes all prior agreements or negotiations, all of which are merged into and incorporated into this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the other provisions of this agreement.

VII. Choice of Law, Jurisdiction, and Venue. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Iowa without regard to conflict-of-law principles, except as otherwise specifically required for the storing and displaying of fireworks as set forth by State and Federal law. Notwithstanding, the Parties must bring any legal or equitable action or proceeding arising under or related to this Agreement exclusively in the Iowa District Court in and for Des Moines County, Iowa. The Iowa District Court in and for Des Moines County, Iowa shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide any disputes arising out of or related to this Agreement. Each party knowingly and voluntarily consents to and expressly waives any objection or defense to personal jurisdiction, improper or inconvenient venue, or inconvenient forum in the Iowa District Court in and for Des Moines County, Iowa.

We follow DOT regulations to transport all equipment and fireworks to the display site on the day of the display. Therefore, no on-site storage is required.

RES Pyro understands the importance of adhering to the NFPA 1123 code. We use fiberglass and HDPE mortars for launching shells, which are configured in racks and placed in banks.

From the time of arrival on site until they leave following the cleanup of the site, the display crew is always watching for unauthorized access to the site by the public. This involves working in conjunction with the local authority having jurisdiction so both parties have a complete understanding of the site perimeter.

During the display, members of the display crew are assigned as spotters to watch for malfunctioning firework effects and breach of the safety perimeter by the public.

After the conclusion of the display, the crew will conduct a thorough inspection of the fallout zone and clear any remaining live product, if necessary. Following this, all equipment, product debris, and packaging will be removed from the launch site.

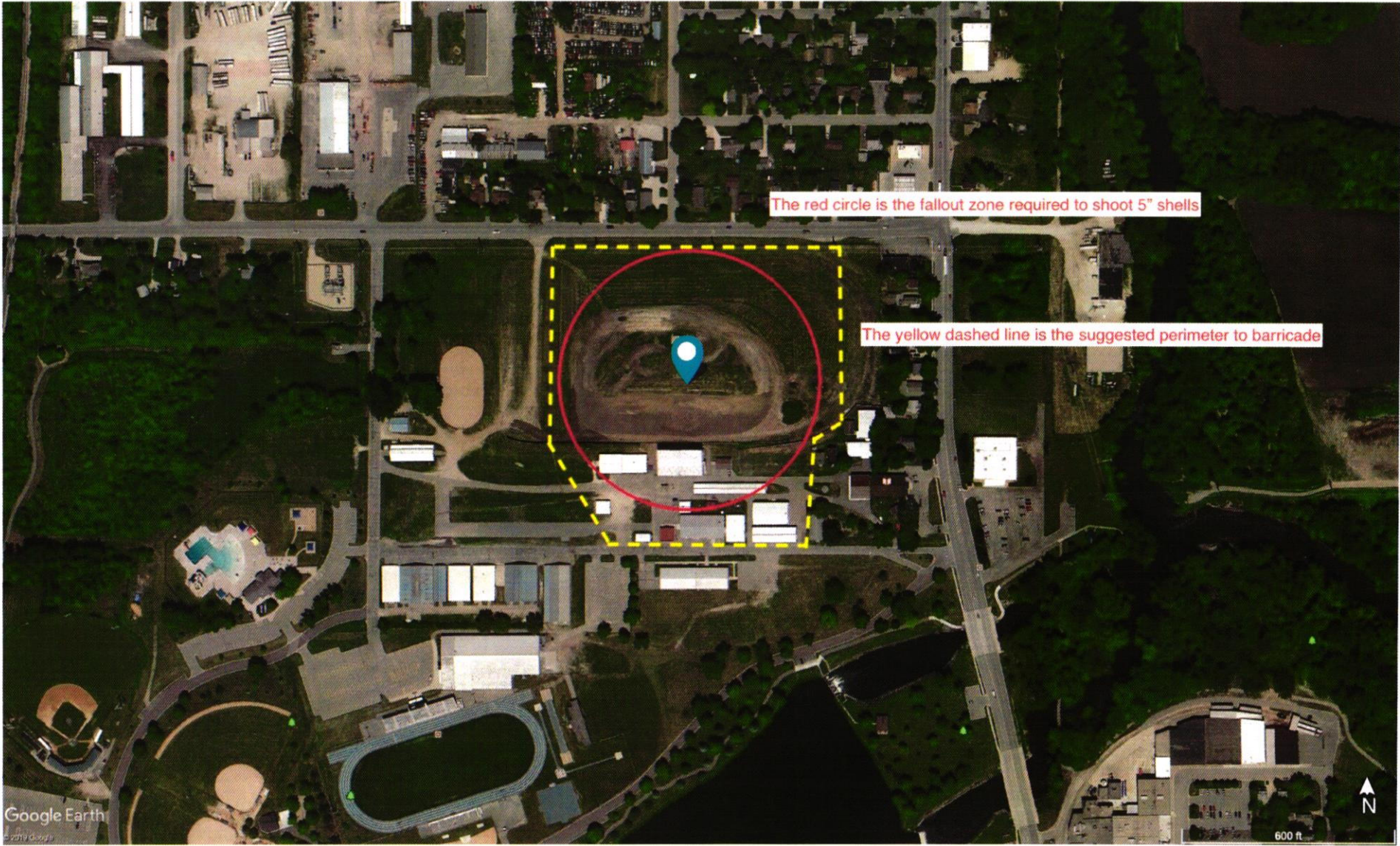
