



EMERGENCY CITY COUNCIL MEETING- MINUTES

Call to Order

The emergency meeting of the City Council was called to order by Mayor Voracek at 7:29 pm. Councilors in attendance included Sara Caron, Adama Doumbouya, Royal Ross, Peter van Sluis, Tom Spooner and Chuck Thiele. Also in attendance was City Administrator Jessica Kinser, City Clerk Heather Slechta, Police Chief John Sherwin, City Engineer Mark DuChene, Fire and Code Services Director Dustin Dienst and Community and Economic Development Director David Wanberg.

Items for Discussion

Resolution 2024-136 Extending the Declared Local State of Emergency for the City of Faribault, Minnesota

City Administrator Jessica Kinser stated that Mayor Voracek signed a proclamation declaring a state of emergency due to flooding on Saturday, June 20th, which the Council approved by resolution at the June 25th City Council meeting. The resolution adopted by the City Council had an end date of June 30th. Upon consultation with Chief Dienst, he recommended extension of the local emergency due to water still being present in areas where a full damage assessment has not been complete. The resolution has the extension going through July 24th, which allows for the Council to extend the emergency on the July 23rd meeting if necessary. Chief Dienst stated that the FEMA emergency declaration will last until the last river crests.

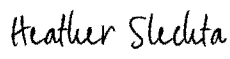
