SUBJECT: Provide Direction on Holding a Separate Work Session for Planning Commission Updates

Discussion:

The Planning Commission did not have a work session on May 2. Therefore, Staff added an "Updates" item to the regular session agenda (similar to what the City Council does). Staff feels that if there are no substantial work session items, there is no need to hold a separate work session simply to update the Commission on Council and EDA actions. However, the Planning Commission requested that it discuss (in a work session setting) if the Commission should hold a work session every meeting to allow a time to listen and respond to Council and EDA updates, and any other topics the Commission wants to discuss. Any significant discussion would require that the discussion item be posted on the work session agenda per the open meeting law. Staff is requesting direction on how to handle future updates.
